Due to the global nature of its business, UBS Group AG (the UBS parent company) is subject to a wide range of regulatory oversight, including oversight of its U.S. public finance business. We are involved in a variety of claims, disputes, legal proceedings and governmental and regulatory inquiries and investigations in jurisdictions where we are active and such matters from time to time include matters involving our municipal securities or public finance business. As part of the securities industry registration and licensing process, UBS and its employees are required to disclose certain arbitration awards, disciplinary, financial and regulatory events. In addition actions by regulatory authorities against current or former employees are also disclosed. Information in this regard is available on FINRA's BrokerCheck website (https://brokercheck.finra.org/). This information includes disclosures related to not only the broker dealer through which UBS conducts its public finance business (currently UBS Financial Services Inc.) but to our parent company (UBS Group AG) and other UBS Affiliates.
