REQUEST FOR SPACE ASSIGNMENT – ADDITIONAL STORAGE SPACE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (LADOT) AT 1111 MATEO STREET, LOS ANGELES, CA 90021

The Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) requests the assignment of approximately 25,080 square feet (sf) of unassigned warehouse space at 1111 Mateo Street, Los Angeles, CA 90021.

While the Council authority for the lease specified that it was for LADOT use, the original program for LADOT revealed that there would be more space than what was needed for LADOT. The unassigned space at 1111 Mateo Street was previously under consideration to address the file storage needs of other City Departments such as the Office of the City Clerk. However, those needs have been addressed and the space is no longer needed to store files.

LADOT can fully utilize the unassigned space to address the critical storage needs of multiple LADOT divisions. The additional space will be utilized as-is to store and secure various materials, items, and equipment that are instrumental to the operation of multiple LADOT programs such as Vision Zero, Active Transportation, LA AI Fresco, Signal Field Operations, and more.

BACKGROUND

LADOT currently utilizes approximately 19,240 square feet for office and storage space at the 1111 Mateo Street warehouse. In addition, they currently store various materials, items, and equipment at another warehouse located at 1201 Mateo Street, Los Angeles, CA 90021.

The LADOT Equipment Repair Shop, currently located at 430 East Commercial Street, will relocate to 1201 Mateo Street. The Department of General Services (GSD)





Construction Forces Division will begin the final phase of construction work and improvements at the 1201 Mateo Street location to accommodate the Equipment Repair Shop. Materials, items, and equipment for these other LADOT divisions are temporarily stored at 1201 Mateo Street but need a permanent home. Once assigned, LADOT will be able to move the materials and equipment from 1201 Mateo Street to 1111 Mateo Street so that GSD Construction Forces can complete the necessary work at 1201 Mateo Street.

- Diagram and floor plan of the 1111 Mateo Street warehouse (outlines the areas to be utilized by each division)
- List of different types of materials and equipment to be moved (not all-inclusive)
- Photographs of materials and equipment (not all-inclusive)

Pursuant to Council File 96-0426, the Department of General Services (GSD) has the authority to assign up to 5,000 square feet (sf) for City departments in City owned space and provide notification to the Municipal Facilities Committee (MFC). This space exceeds that amount and is within leased space. Therefore, GSD is requesting MFC approval to assign the remaining 25,080 sf to LADOT.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no additional impact on the General Fund at this time.

RECOMMENDATION


That the Municipal Facilities Committee approves this Space Assignment for the Department of Transportation as substantially outlined in this report.

Types of Materials, Items, and Equipment (Not All-Inclusive)

Vision Zero

- Up to 500 pieces ZICLA vectorial platforms (ranges from 1.5' x 1.5' to 2' x 0.5')
- Possibly store an assembled platform measuring 60' x 7' approximately 500 bollards at a time (29" H x 8" W each)
- RRFB units up to 50 sets (boxes at least 2' x 2')
- 25 RRFB cabinet/solar panels (25" W x 25" H x 2" D)
- Approximately 25 radar speed signs measuring 33" H x 30" W x 6" D
- Approximately 100 modular speed bumps measuring 13" x 11" x 2"
- Approximately 25 modular traffic island units measuring 4' x 4'

Markout/Striping Support for Various LADOT Programs

- 1080 K-71 white bollards, 18 pallets
- 540 K-71 yellow bollards, 9 pallets
- 500 White T-curb with bollards, 3 pallets
- 500 Yellow T-curb with bollards, 3 pallets
- 200 Black/yellow tough bumps (rubber speed bumps), 3 pallets
- 500 Paddle signs with bases, 4 pallets
- Preform thermoplastic various legends, 25 pallets

Active Transportation

- 9 Pallets of bollards 29" H x 8" W each, 60 per pallet
- 13 Bike shape racks, 65" long x 42" tall
- 9 Pallets of bike racks, 25 racks per pallet
- 2 Pallets of parking blocks, 6'
- 1 Pallet of parking blocks, 3'

- 2 Pallets of cycle hoops

LA AI Fresco

- Approximately 200 pieces of water K-rail. Each piece is approximately 80 lbs. and the dimensions are 6' L x 18" W x 32" H
- Up to 40 planters, 30" H, 64 lbs. each
- Approximately 80 shade umbrellas and bases
- Approximately 100 bollards, 29" H x 8" W each

Signal Field Operations

- Traffic signal LED modules approximately 50 to 75 pallets (42" x 52")
- Traffic signal controller cabinets approximately 10 to 20 on pallets (30" x 40")
- Traffic signal heads
