

There are three main systems that address homelessness in Los Angeles County

- **Prevention** requires preserving affordable housing stock and addressing income insecurity, anti-discrimination efforts, and the mainstream social safety net through policy and legislation.
- **Housing Creation** is the building of housing for all income levels and investing in permanent supportive housing.
- **Rehousing System** is the end-to-end system that focuses on placing people experiencing homelessness into temporary and permanent housing through several programs LAHSA administers through its service providers.



LA's homeless rehousing system responded to the onset of the COVID-19 crisis with a quickly organized multi-agency collaboration. Some of the initiatives included:

- **Project Roomkey** – Brought more than **6,000 vulnerable people** inside in just a few months.
- **LA Public Recreation Center Shelters** – Over **1,800 people** have been provided services across **25 City Rec. and Park Sites**.
- **Personal Protective Equipment Distribution** – Over **300,000 pairs of gloves** and over **20,000 masks** were distributed.
- **Meal Delivery** – Over **462,000 meals** were distributed.
- **Medical Screening** – More than **36,000 wellness checks** performed since April by our outreach teams.
- **COVID Education** – Over **7,000 people** experiencing homelessness received COVID-specific education from our outreach teams.
- **Winter Shelter Extension** – Currently, **12 shelters** are offering **hundreds of beds 24 hours** across LA County.



- Clients are assessed for appropriate housing interventions
- High needs clients are prioritized for PSH
- Prioritized clients are matched to vacant PSH units and tenant based rental subsidies
- Housing Central Command Coordinates homeless service providers, PSH developers/PM companies, and the Housing Authorities to expedite lease ups
