Outreach in the time of COVID has meant a constant reimagining of how to provide life-saving and -sustaining resources safely and swiftly.

LAHSA has been key in making this happen





Street-based services in times of crisis with no precedence


- When other mainstream, health, social services closed, outreach teams didn't miss a beat
- Life for unsheltered was extremely difficult in early days of pandemic
 - Street outreach was a lifeline
- LAHSA and partners had to research and create safe ways to do this work
 - Create and recreate protocols for every single thing outreach workers do





HOTSPOT: COVID wellness checks

- LAHSA with Akido Labs developed a cutting-edge app for outreach teams
 - provide wellness checks
 - triage COVID-symptomatic clients
 - connect clients to PRK
 - drive testing to potential outbreaks
- Conducted 42,520 wellness checks to date
- Identified almost 300 symptomatic people






Getting unsheltered Angelenos safely indoors

- LAHSA HET and partner outreach teams mobilized for thousands of interim housing opportunities throughout the pandemic
 - City of LA Recs and Parks (RAP) sites
 - Project Roomkey (PRK)
 - A Bridge Home
- Outreach teams played chief role in identifying, communicating, and connecting unsheltered people experiencing homelessness in record speed

Distributing key resources among the most vulnerable

- Outreach teams and coordinators established unprecedented distribution networks
 - PPE
 - Food
 - 4,500 meals a day
 - Hand washing kits
 - Hand sanitizer





Education and training

- As early as March 2020, LAHSA worked closely with DHS medical team to create training curriculum on how to do outreach safely
- Started a weekly County-wide COVID training meet-up for all outreach teams that is still in place
- Supporting teams during this extremely difficult time remains mission critical





Street-based COVID testing and vaccination

- Launched large-scale street-based testing with Mayor's office and City Fire in Skid Row and key City encampments
 - Connections to Isolation and Quarantine
 - Support for sheltering in place
 - Education on how to protect yourself and others
 - Other linkages
- Strong linkages to DHS/DPH testing
- Outreach workers prioritized to receive vaccines
- Just started vaccinations of 65+ PEH in encampments





Key LAHSA City HET Outcomes from FY 20-21, Q1 and Q2

>3,000

People contacted on the streets each Quarter

>2,000

Engaged with life sustaining resources and services each Quarter

>400

Moved into Interim Housing.

Looking ahead

- Continue this life-saving work
- Ramping up of vaccination of unsheltered PEH
- Connecting eligible clients to Roadmap and Recovery Rehousing resources
