(FISCAL YEARS 2024-25 THROUGH 2026-27)

#### RECOMMENDATION

That the L.A. for Kids Steering Committee receive and file the funding recommendations provided by the Regional Volunteer Neighborhood Oversight Committees.

### **SUMMARY**

The annual funding deliberations for the Proposition K program begin each year with the convening of three Regional Volunteer Neighborhood Oversight Committees (RVNOC) for the Central, Southern and Valley regions. Each of the fifteen Council Offices has the opportunity to appoint two RVNOC members to represent District funding priorities. At the conclusion of the annual deliberations, the proposed RVNOC expenditure plans are presented to the Steering Committee for further deliberation. Each of the RVNOC bodies met between February 7, 2024 and February 22, 2024. The chart below provides a summary of the RVNOC funding recommendations, with a detailed breakdown provided in the report Attachments.

#### DISCUSSION

#### PROPOSITION K FUNDS

Proposition K funds two types of projects: 1) those that were specified in the Ballot Measure; and, 2) those awarded through a competitive process open to City entities, other governmental agencies and qualified non-profit agencies. Specified and competitive projects are further divided into local and regional categories. As there was no active competitive cycle for Fiscal Year 2024-25, the RVNOC body has deliberated and provided funding for specified projects only.

The RVNOC recommendations for specified projects includes recommended funding for the upcoming year (2024-25) as summarized below, along with funding earmarks for subsequent years as reflected in the report attachments.

### Specified Funding Recommendations: (Attachments 1, 2 and 3)

The three RVNOC bodies provided funding recommendations for specified projects recommended for funding in Program Year 28 (FY 2024-25), for a total funding level of \$4.2 million citywide. The funding recommendations concurred with recommendations from the Bureau of Engineering, which are based on the availability of specified funds and project readiness in the upcoming fiscal year.
