PUBLIC COMMENT

An opportunity for the public to address the Committee on agenda items for which public hearings have not been held will be provided at the time the item is considered or during the Multiple Agenda Item Comment period. Members of the public who wish to speak on items shall be allowed to speak for up to one minute per item up to a total of three minutes per meeting. The Committee has determined that a cumulative total of 20 minutes is a reasonable minimum amount of time for the Multiple Agenda Item segment of each regular meeting.

The Committee will also provide an opportunity for the public to speak on public interest items. Each speaker shall be limited to one minute of general public comment each regular meeting for a cumulative total of ten (10) minutes. The Committee shall not discuss or take action relative to any general public comment.

Testimony shall be limited in content to matters which are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Committee. The Committee may not take any action nor engage in any discussion on matters presented during this general public comment period. The purpose of public comment is to allow the public to address the Committee and the Committee is interested in hearing from members of the public, stakeholders and interested parties. However, speakers are asked to exercise courtesy and consider the rights of other speakers by adhering to the time limits set forth and if possible refrain from unnecessary repetition in their comments
